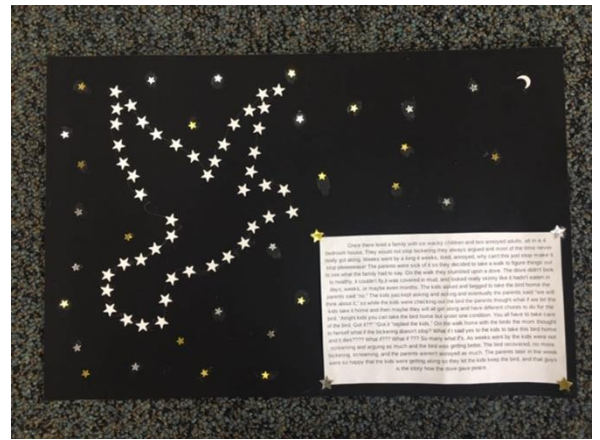

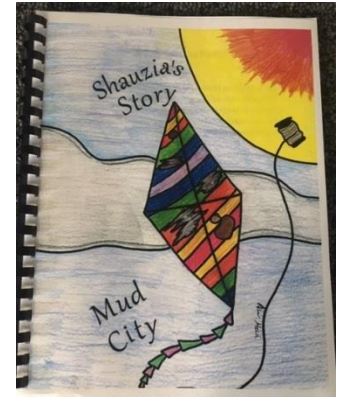
## Mythology
